**How Many Courses are required to Qualify for the Postgraduate Certificate in Information Security?**

Training will be delivered in modules of 1.5 days on a Friday evening and a Saturday. This requires 10 modules of 1.5 days to make the 15 day requirement. The approximate times are Friday evening 6pm to 9pm. This session will last 3.5 hours including a 20 minute break. Saturday - 9.30am to 4.30pm - with 1 hour lunch-break. **(these usually carry on until about 5pm after questions and rolling up the day).**

Participants who pass the taught component become eligible to be awarded a Postgraduate Certificate. However, this certificate will only be awarded to such students who do not go on to complete the requirements for the award of the Postgraduate Diploma.

Registration for the Diploma requires a separate academic fee payable direct to Royal Holloway University of London.

For those participants who wish to move on to the Diploma, there is a cost of £2,000 sterling payable direct to the University.

***N.B. Due to the dynamic nature of the subject and the rapid developments and changes in professional practice, the range and type of courses offered in any year may differ slightly from the above. Students will be notified before enrollment of any changes to the programme, and all such changes will be subject to the approval of the RHUL Programme Amendments Panel.***
